



## **Tiller Guidelines and Rules**

### ***Heritage Community Garden and Park***

The tiller is available for the gardeners that purchased it or into it with a Key Fee. If you did not purchase the tiller or have not paid into the tiller with your “Key Fee” you must arrange for tilling by contacting Natalie Vreeland or the Heritage Community Garden Coordinator to obtain permission. The Key Fee is \$25.00 one time fee for full access to the tiller.

Key holders and/or anyone using the tiller will be issued a key by the Heritage Community Garden Coordinator and asked to sign a waiver of liability, a safety agreement, and a responsibility agreement for any damages that happen to the tiller while it is in your possession or if you were the last to use it.

1. When using the tiller, you must agree to:
2. Have a lesson with Natalie before using the tiller for the first time
3. Have a signed agreement of liability and responsibility on file
4. Use all safety precautions which include wearing boots, gloves and safety glasses
5. Check and top off all fuel and oil before and after use.
6. Fill the gas can and replace the oil if you use them up.
7. Not over-heat the engine.
8. Return the tiller clean and free of all debris in the tines.
9. Lock the cleaned tiller in the shed, ready for the next gardener to use.
10. Replace all broken or lost parts, including lost pins in the axel.
11. I will not take the tiller off HCG property unless authorized.
12. I will return my key to Heritage Community Garden Coordinator when I give back my garden.
13. I will not give my key to anyone.
14. I will use the tiller for my garden only.
15. I will pay for a replacement if I lose my key.

# Tiller Agreement of Use Statement

I agree to follow all of the rules established by Heritage Community Gardens concerning the use of the tiller and to submit a signed copy of this agreement.

## Responsibility for the care of the Equipment

I agree to take full responsibility for any broken, damaged or non-working parts of the tiller while I am using it and will pay for parts and repairs to the tiller if damage occurs while I am using the tiller.

## Waiver of Liability

I will not hold Heritage Community Gardens or their partners responsible for any injury that I receive while working with the tiller or working in my garden. I take full responsibility for my safety, health and ability to perform physical labor.

## Safety Agreement

I will use all safety equipment when using the tiller. I will wear safety glasses, gloves and closed toed shoes when tilling in the garden. I will turn off all equipment before cleaning tines or replacing fuel.

I have read and agree to the Responsibility for care of the equipment, Waiver of Liability, and Safety agreement.
